## **Chicago Brewing District's Dancing in the Streets Brings First-ever Jam Band & Craft Beer Festival to West Town**

### ***Dancing in the Streets Features Two Days of Craft Beer and Jam Bands, August 4-5***

**CHICAGO (June 20, 2018)** – The West Town Chamber of Commerce has partnered with the Chicago Brewing District, the Industrial Council of Nearwest Chicago, and On Tour Brewing to present the first-ever Dancing in the Streets jam band and brew festival. Featuring 10 craft beer varieties from the Chicago Brewing District brewers and touring jam bands booked by On Tour Brewing, the one-of-a-kind festival will also boast an array of local artisans and makers from the Kinzie Industrial corridor, West Town restaurants, retailers and food trucks for patrons to enjoy all weekend long.

The event will feature two craft beer varieties from the following Chicago Brewing District brewers: Goose Island Beer Company, Great Central Brewing Company, Finch Beer Co., and On Tour Brewing, plus Forbidden Root. In addition, a Specialty Beer Rotating Tap (cash only) which will feature a rotating schedule of limited special brews throughout the weekend including Goose Island's coveted 2017 Bourbon County Stout Coffee beer from 2pm-3pm both Saturday and Sunday.

The \$20 Beer Sampler Ticket will allow patrons to sample six (6) craft beers from the main bar (not valid at the Specialty Tap). Spirit sponsors Prairie Organic Vodka and Douglas & Todd Bourbon will also be on hand with complimentary samples of vodka and bourbon cocktails, full size versions of which will be also be for sale at the main bar.

#### **The Fine Print**

There is an optional \$5 donation requested for entry to Dancing in the Streets. Proceeds from the event benefit local non-profits, the West Town Chamber of Commerce, The Arts of Life, and Chicago Neighbors United.
